## Outstanding Project Safety Award Competition

### **PURPOSE AND GENERAL INFORMATION**

This award is presented to the Owner-Contractor Team demonstrating the most outstanding commitment to safety as well as an excellent statistical record on a particular project.

A project can be nominated by a contractor, individual, owner or design professional.

All types of projects will be considered including commercial, industrial, new construction, institutional, renovation or maintenance.

To be eligible, the project must have been completed between March 19, 2011 and March 16, 2012. "Phases" of one larger project can be considered as unique projects, if evidence is presented to the judges that warrant treating the "phase" as separate and distinct from the whole project.

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### **APPLICATION**

The provided application should serve as a cover sheet for this submission. All submissions should be submitted electronically in PDF or a Microsoft Office based format. 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### **ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS**

In addition to the application, each entrant must include:

- Total Recordable Incident Rates for the project (TRIR)
- Days Away including Restricted and Transfer for the project (DART)
- A narrative of any reasonable length listing programs, policies and other evidence of an outstanding commitment to safety on the project. Highlighting working conditions or other unique circumstances will help the judges distinguish applicants (e.g. types of hazard exposures, number of different contractors, complexity of the project.)
- A list of all contractors who were significantly involved in the project. MICCS will acknowledge at the Awards Celebration only the first ten listed contractors, should the project win the award.

*Please note: It is possible that more than one contractor may want to nominate the same project. To avoid duplicate entries, contractors must contact the project manager representing the "owner" to be certain that the project is not already being nominated by another. If such is the case, then the owner and contractors should insure that the project is nominated only once.*

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## IN ADDITION/ ENTRY DEADLINE

The Awards Committee requests that the following also be provided. Should circumstances prohibit fulfilling these requests, the applicant should be aware that in the announcements regarding these awards, other companies may benefit from the increased exposure that these requests are intended to provide:

- Images of persons from *the owner and contractor companies* presented in .JPG or .TIF format, which may be shown to the audience when the nominated project is announced at the Awards Celebration. Please do not embed these graphic files in other files or documents. Images should be emailed to [mwatson@miccs.org](mailto:mwatson@miccs.org)
- Images of *project pictures*. These may be shown to the audience when the nominated project is announced. Images should be emailed to [mwatson@miccs.org](mailto:mwatson@miccs.org)

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## THE OUTSTANDING PROJECT SAFETY AWARD

MICCS will award up to three different outstanding project awards:

1. Large
2. Medium
3. Small

Categories cannot necessarily be defined until the judges receive the submissions and evaluate what was submitted.

Rationale: to encourage teams that have put together a project that has performed at exceptionally high safety levels to submit no matter the size of a project. In this way, MICCS can recognize many types of projects that have done well in safety.
